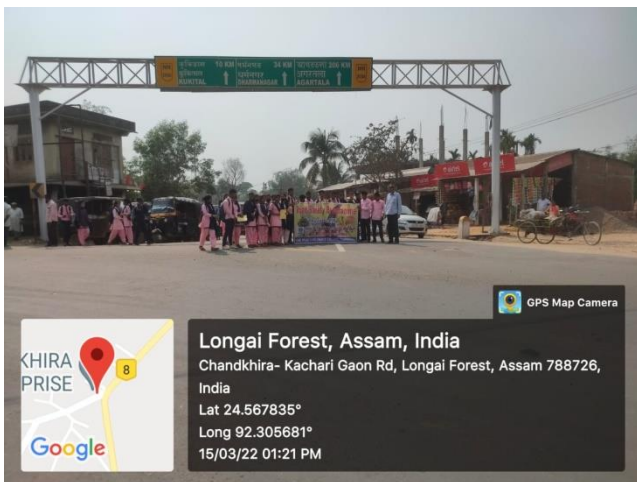
Annual Festival Celebration

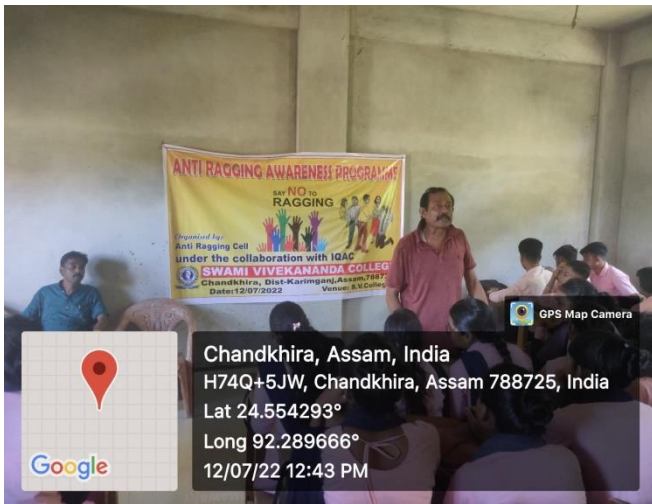
Celebration of World Population Day

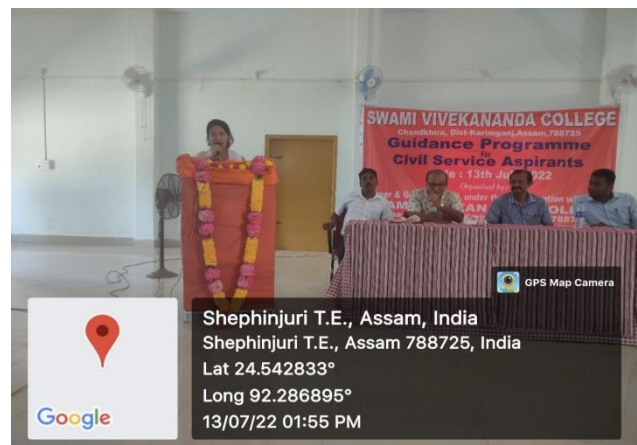
Anti-Ragging Awareness Programme

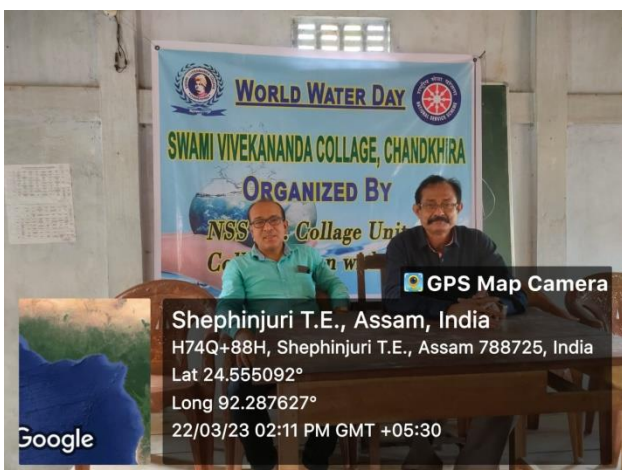
Antarjatic Matribhasa Divas

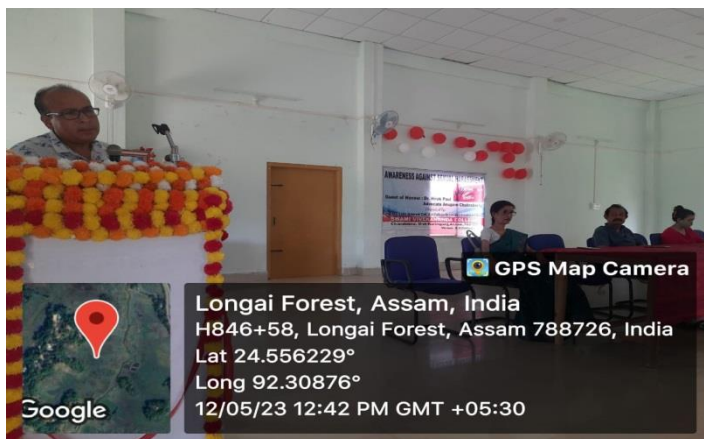
Awareness Program on Anti-Drugs

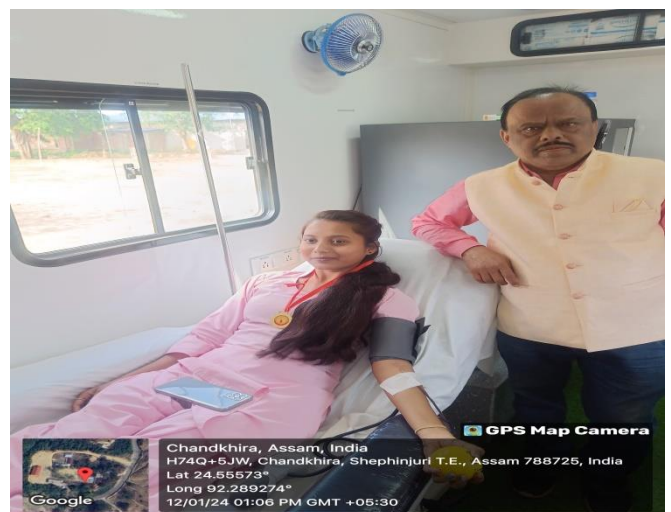

Awareness on Road Safety Programme

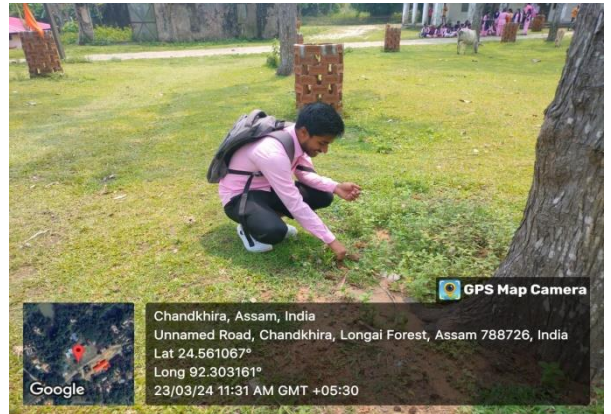
