Research Policy Implementation Mechanism:

The Research and Development Cell of the college will take charge of executing the college's research policy in collaboration with the college administration. The Research and Development Cell will perform the following specific functions:

- 1. Support faculty in conducting research and collaborate with the College administration to establish a research fund for providing initial funding.
- 2. Offer research amenities such as journals, awards, honorariums, and other necessities required by faculty.
- 3. Promote a research culture by offering incentives like teaching workload relief and opportunities to attend conferences.
- 4. Encourage faculty to engage in research collaborations with research organizations/industries.
- 5. Develop procedures to acknowledge and appreciate research contributions appropriately.
- 6. Aid in establishing specific research units/centers through funding from external agencies or the College.
- 7. Organize workshops, training programs, and awareness initiatives to foster a researchoriented environment on campus.
- 8. Prepare budgets to support students' research projects, fieldwork, and surveys.
- Collaborate with national and international organizations like UGC, CSIR, DST-SERB, DST, ICMR, DBT, NATO, DRDO, and BARC to secure funding for major and minor research projects undertaken by faculty and students.
- 10. Enhance the availability of research infrastructure to facilitate research efforts.
- 11. Develop and implement an official Code of Ethics within the Research and Development Cell to prevent malpractices and plagiarism.
- 12. Facilitate interdepartmental/interdisciplinary research projects.
- 13. Encourage faculty and students to pursue publications, research grants, patents, and memberships, and announce awards for annual outstanding achievements.
